## EXODUS: THE BOOK OF REDEMPTION

**A. Author:** Moses

**B. Title:** From the Latin translation of Scripture (Vulgate), meaning "exit, departure, or going out."

**C. Theme:** The redemption by God of His people from slavery, and His grace shown to them by giving the Law and the Tabernacle.

**D. Outline:**

**a. THE RISE OF A REDEEMER (1-2)**

300 years passed between Joseph's death & Moses' birth (1:6)

The new Pharaoh did not honor Joseph's people (1:8-9)

They persecuted the Israelites, but God gave them children, especially with the civil disobedience of the midwives. (1:12)

Moses was born and spared by his mother's plan (2:1ff.)

Moses fled to Midian after killing an Egyptian (2:11ff.)

**The Call of Moses (3:1-4)**

--God came to Moses in a burning bush.

--God revealed His personal name to Moses (יְהוָה) (3:14)

--Objections

Who am I?

Who are you?

I can't speak!

God provided Manna and Moses needed help!
